Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I would like to visit with you for a few moments through this letter. During the last year many wonderful things have been happening at our parish. We are so blessed that you and I have been able to be part of formation of our Youth group, my Installation as the Pastor, Family & Friends, and the Gospel Extravaganza just to mention a few events. Through these opportunities and events, the Holy Spirit has been guiding us to grow closer as a parish family.

Christian life means following Jesus closely so that we may catch a glimpse of His attitudes and start imitating him. Christian life means a commitment to write the Gospel of Jesus into our lives, thus we become the His living Word. We introduce and re-introduce Jesus to others not through words usually but by our very lives mostly.

But we must remember our discipleship is lived not only personally but also communally. We do not journey alone but we journey as a church – a community of believers who empower one another to grow into what Jesus would have us be. Spend the next five weeks with us in prayer and reflection as we talk about the specific gifts needed for this important venture. Then I hope to see you in the actual day-long process which is scheduled for Saturday, June 3, 2017 We will begin with Morning Prayer followed by a continental breakfast. On that day, we will be discerning 5 new positions for Pastoral Council. During the next few weeks, I will be providing you with more details on the actual discernment day.

Respond bravely knowing that the work is not solely yours or mine or your fellow parishioners. The task has been set by our loving Creator. We are mere instruments in God's loving hands. See your smiling faces at Discernment Day, June 3! Let us serve the Lord in joy!

Discernment is the process of making careful distinctions in our thinking about truth. In other words, the ability to think with discernment is synonymous with an ability to think biblically.

First Thessalonians 5:21-22 teaches that it is the responsibility of every Christian to be discerning: "But examine everything carefully; hold fast to that which is good; abstain from every form of evil." The apostle John issues a similar warning when he says, "Do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world" (1 John 4:1). According to the New Testament, discernment is not optional for the believer-it is required.
